EASTER CAMP.

APRIL 15th. - 18th.

The Easter camp this year is in the Mt. Barney area, with a wide range of activities possible. This is the opportunity to get to know Mt. Barney and its surrounding terrain. On the agenda, there is a Base Camp, a two-day thruwalk, and two four-day thruwalks.

Base Camp.

Sat.- an easy day up Midget Peak, on one of the North-west ridges of Mt. Barney. Good views of Leaning Peak, Eagles Ridge, West peak, East Peak, Mt. Ballow, etc, etc.

Sun.- a visit to the Lower Portals, via the ridges, the return journey via the creek.

Mon.- Montseratt Lookout, just above the campsite. One of the best views of Mt. Barney is got from this point. The rest of the day will be taken up in the walk back to the truck, and the wait for the four-day thruwalkers.
