27th-30th March (EASTER) Base Camp at CHRISTMAS CREEK
Throughwalk from TWEED RANGES.

Christmas Creek is one of the best base camping areas near Lamington National Park. In easy reach are Buchanan's Fort, Mt. Widgee, Westray's Grave, Stinson Wreck, Running Creek Falls, Waterfall Ck. falls-etc. Plenty of good swimming.

There will be a small throughwalk also arranged for this area, of two or three days duration.

The main throughwalk will be from Warrazambil Creek, near Wiangaree, along the Tweed Ranges and down Running Creek to the Base Camp. Attractions are the waterfalls on Running and Warrazambil Creeks, the Superb View from the Pinnacle and the razorbacks of the Tweed Range area. This will be fairly long and hard, so those who have not been throughwalking before are strongly advised to go on the smaller throughwalk from base camp.

Deposits to be paid by the 18th March. More details of transport later.
